

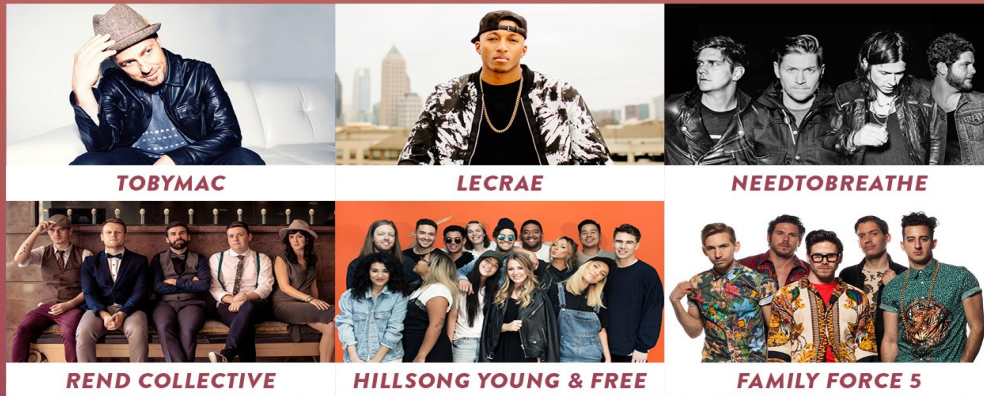

St. Michael Youth Ministry

Schedule:

- We will meet at St. Michael at 5:30 am to Pack and Leave (Please eat before arrival)
 - We will return home on Sunday to St. Michael at 3:00 pm
- For a complete festival schedule and list of artists, go to www.alive.org .

Lodgings:

- We will be staying in tents (a boy's tent and a girl's tent and two leader tents) for the entire festival. There are bathrooms as well as a limited number of shower facilities available at the campgrounds.

Meals:

We will have scheduled meal times at our camp. If your group chooses to eat the "fair food" for a meal or if there is an artist going on you really want to see, instead of a meal with the group, please let Fraz know so we are not waiting on you. Also, we will all be taking turns cooking and cleaning throughout the week as well as retrieving water for the campsite.

Cost:

\$125 per person which covers meals, tickets, and camping. Similar to NCYC, there are plenty of booths to buy t-shirts, cd's, etc as well as plenty of "fair food" type vendors at the event so you may want spending money at the event for these things. Youth can fundraise for this event. Please ask the office for fundraising opportunities.

List of Things You Will Need:

- Clothes
- Toiletries (Soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Good walking shoes
- Flashlight
- Towel and Washcloth
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Socks (bring plenty to keep your toes warm!!!)
- Pajamas
- An open mind
- Rain Gear!
- Bible and/or Journal
- A Reusable Water Bottle! (There is a station at the Concerts to Refill them for Free!!!)
- Money for souvenirs, cds, etc. (\$40 should be more than enough)
- Bathing Suit (There is a lake to swim in.) -Please no bikinis or speedos. Remember modesty is a part of the dress code for the entire weekend.

Other optional things:

- Camera
- Guitar or other Musical Instrument
- Sheet Music or Tabs
- Deck of Cards

-Drawing Tablet

Do not bring:

- Personal CD Players, MP3 Players, or Radios
- Drugs or Alcohol
- Fireworks
- A Bad Attitude
- Food or candy in your suitcase- the critters will make their ways into tents

Should I Bring My Cell Phone?

Yes, please bring your cell phone. Fraz will put together a list of everyone's numbers for you to have just in case you get separated from the group. I do ask that you keep cell phone use to a minimum (calling home to mom and dad, etc.) The point of the week is to spend time together not with your friends or significant other who didn't come along with us. Please keep social media to a minimum and keep phones in pockets while hanging out with others at camp and concerts. There is no electric at the campsite to charge your phone.

Rules:

The normal youth ministry rules apply such as:

- Showing Up on Time to Check Ins
- Cell Phones must be kept to limited use (Remember there is no where to charge them)
- Clothing Must Be Appropriate (No Boobs, Butts, Bellies, or Boxers should be seen)
- No Writing on the backside of Pants or Shorts
- No Purple, Hot Pink, or Navy Blue
- Be Yourself
- Live out the Golden Rule
- Listen if Others are Talking
- Respect Others Personal Space (in tents, around camp, etc)
- Pick up After Yourself
- 1 Put Down = 3 Put Ups
- Language and Conversation Must Be Youth Ministry Appropriate

Also added to this are that you must be with an adult at all times and let Fraz know where you are going, there are to be no boys in the girls tent or vice-a-versa (this is a call home for your parents to come pick you up automatically), and no drugs, alcohol or tobacco (also an all expense paid trip home by your parents). Jr. High Students must also be with an adult at all times around the festival grounds.

Your Faith:

The festival is open to all faiths and as such, there are many different expressions of Christianity being put forth at the festival. You may be challenged at the festival about your Catholic faith and asked questions such as "Are you saved?" or "When were you saved?" We will talk about how to answer these questions on the trip. People are not asking to insult you, they simply have a different view on parts of our faith.
