Who—Anyone entering grade 9 through 2018 high school graduates.

Transportation—All transportation for the week is provided by personal vehicles of our adults. Adult drivers are Safe Environment compliant and have had criminal history background checks.

Chaperones—There is a minimum of one adult for every six youth. All adults are Safe Environment-compliant and have had a criminal history background checks.

Activities—Participants will work at specified organizations in the Grand Rapids area and will participate in social activities, games, faith discussions, and prayer experiences.

Cost—\$150 covers 4 nights stay in Aquinas College dorms, meals, activities, supplies, and transportation. *Partial or full scholarships are available for families in need.*
