FAQ #1 Where will we meet and when?

Answer: We will meet as a group at the front gate to Kentucky Kingdom at 9:20 a.m.  
Students will need to be picked up at 7 p.m.

FAQ #2 Will I need other money for the day?

Answer: Lunch will be provided, but you will need to bring money for dinner and drinks throughout the day.

FAQ #3 What is the dress code for the day?

Answer: Youth need to be appropriately dressed (no breasts, bellies, butts or boxers should be visible.) If you are planning on going to the water park, girls must be in a **one piece** bathing suit or Tankini and boys need to be in something other than a Speedo.

FAQ #4 What is the cell phone policy for the day?

Answer: We are asking youth to leave their phones at home. All participants will receive the phone number of the group leader prior to day at Kentucky Kingdom.

FAQ #5 How do I sign up and can I sign up late?
